Title	EUORPEAN OUTDOOR CITY GAMES (Acronym: G.E.C.O)
Objective & Priority	To organize local European events in several EU Member States in order to encourage healthy lifestyles for all, in particular through: ✓ the implementation of the three pillars of the HealthyLifestyle4All initiative; ✓ the implementation of the Council Recommendation on the cross-sectoral promotion of healthy physical activity and the EU Physical Activity Guidelines ✓ support for the implementation of the European Week of Sport, ✓ the promotion of sport and physical activity as a tool for health ✓ the promotion of all activities that encourage the practice of sport and physical activity ✓ the promotion of sport and traditional games.
Idea of the Project	The project promotes the adoption of healthy lifestyles and physical activity through the practice of outdoor sports to be played in urban and extra-urban areas. The participating European Municipalities make their resources and territories available to launch an important container of events, an exclusively amateur format, in the name of sustainable sport by organizing a great traveling challenge and aspire to the title of European city of outdoor sport. The project proposes an overall program of European events (No. 1 event for each Partner City/municipality) focused on outdoor sports and games in neighboring urban and suburban areas. Each event will have an effective duration of 3 days (excluding arrivals and departures) on weekends. In each country involved in the project, an event will be organized in which teams made up of about twenty representatives of the municipalities of the partner countries will participate. The inter-disciplinary teams will compete in the following sports events and games: trail running, mountain biking, urban trekking, free climbing, orienteering, tug of war, archery, plogging run. The result of each test will

	determine the final classification. In each team there will be participants of all ages, from the youngest to the oldest to people with disabilities. The technical-sports program will be accompanied by an equally important program of collateral initiatives: conferences, workshops, laboratories, demonstrations, meetings with champions and ex-athletes, recreational-educational initiatives for children and families, moments of thematic study, dissemination initiatives, exchange of good practices, entertainment and animation. On the occasion of the last event, the final award and thanksgiving ceremony will be organized and the new European cities/municipalities will be publicly selected which, in the follow-up of the project, will become part of the outdoor games. The proposed format will be of high innovative value, strongly oriented towards inclusion, digitalisation, sustainability and the enhancement of the principles of sport, of the European historical-cultural and environmental heritage and its values. The project will feature an important Communication Plan with an international dimension based on an effective brand strategy and the use of the web and social media.
